As a 24/7 residential facility, holiday coverage is shared by all residential staff.

JOB FUNCTION

This highly relational position shares responsibility for guidance and supervision of each resident of The Elizabeth House. This person oversees the physical care of each resident, encourages acceptable habits and attitudes, fosters a safe and warm community environment, manages resident behavior, and offers residents support to meet their program goals and objectives.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES – ESSENTIAL FUNCTION OF JOB

- 1. Oversee evening and/or weekend activities of residents
- 2. Work with program staff to welcome and orient new residents with becoming acquainted with the schedule and expectations of the program
- 3. Help residents maintain accountability regarding daily/weekly responsibilities, including meal planning and preparation, household cleanliness, and household safety
- 4. Support incentive program for resident goal achievement program. Document and communicate achievements to appropriate program staff.
- 5. Understand and follow all policies and procedures, including those regarding medical or other emergencies and onset of labor.
- 6. Be willing to step in as emergency relief staff on occasions when needed
- 7. Work with volunteers, including church groups, to support development of relationships with between volunteers, residents, and the ministry
- 8. Other duties as assigned

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS & ABILITIES

- A. Service and people oriented, having the ability to relate to people of diverse cultures, including various economic and ethnic backgrounds, in a friendly and professional manner
- B. Ability to motivate and capable of handling crisis in a calm, professional manner. Training in Trauma-Informed Care preferred
- C. Able to deal with confidential information in a confidential manner

- D. Relies on experience and judgment to plan and accomplish goals; performing a variety of tasks and working under general supervision
- E. Take responsibility for the evening and/or weekend activities of the Home, prioritizing a caring relationship with residents while maintaining accountability to the program
- F. Promote a community environment that is joyful, relaxing and peaceful
- G. Provide spiritual leadership to residents as a loving Christian, able to guide and direct in crisis situations in a gentle and non-judgmental manner
- H. Able to work with and care for infants; workable knowledge of parenting education and child development
- I. Use good judgment in recognizing illness and problems associated with pregnancy, labor, etc.
- J. Manage donations of material goods for The Elizabeth House and oversee writing of thank you notes
