Patient Advocate: Walk with the patient through the medical process, collecting basic information, and meeting her where she is at with truth and love. Requires excellent communication and organizational skills. Requires a 4 hour, weekly commitment.

Patient Resource Specialist: Follow-up with patient post medical, building a relationship of trust. Providing patient with resources allowing them to thrive. Posses strong critical thinking and relational skills, and excellent attention to detail.

Receptionists: Be the welcoming face to all patients and clients who enter. Check patients and clients in when they arrive. Answer the phone and transfer calls. Do light administration tasks as needed. Must be willing to serve 2 times per month minimum.

General Admin: Help with filing, copy/fax/scan/shred, records retention, and/or HR.

Delivery and Pickups: Help us with occasional diaper, blanket/quilt pickups, food bank deliveries for both the First Care Clinic and The Elizabeth House

Baby Bottle Champions: (4 or 5 people needed) Help prepare baby bottles for distribution, deliver to churches and/or process returned bottles. See how change is necessary for LIFE!

Development Assistance: Help with mailings, folding, stamping, and addressing envelopes. Also, looking for assistance with phone correspondence and data entry.

Money Counters: Help our Finance Director count incoming gifts after campaigns and events.

Maternity home overnight volunteers: (Three needed) Do life with moms and form bonds of friendship and encouragement. Overnight staff fill in when regular staff is not available. Shifts are from 5:00 pm in the evening to 8:30 am in the morning. Weekend 48-hour shifts are available too. Married couples are welcome.

Maternity home helpers: (3 needed) Support the moms living in The Elizabeth House by dedicating two hours a week to help moms who are managing young children and daily living activities. You may be asked to watch or play with a child; help sterilize bottles or assist in other ways as moms request.

Hospitality Coordinator: (1 or 2 people) This person recruits, trains, and supports a group of hospitality volunteers with the goal of supporting ministry events where food and drink are needed. Examples include staff and volunteer training events, open houses, Care Net monthly vision tours. **Hospitality volunteers**: (unlimited) Provide food and drink for special events including staff and volunteer training, open houses, Care Net monthly vision tours. Food can be prepared or purchased by a small group or church, delivered and set up in time for special event under the direction of the Hospitality Coordinator.

Event support: Be a part of the banquet team. Set up, recruitment of table hosts, helping with name tags and other prep.

Medical volunteers: Nurses, and Nurse Practitioners are needed to provide direct patient care.

Physicians: We need physicians with experience in sexual transmitted infections to review charts. About one hour per month requirement.
